NEW Pool Schedule (Weather Permitting):

Skyview: Opens June 17th to Sept. 5th (Labor Day)
Hours*: June 17th – August 21st = 12:00 pm – 7:45 pm
August 22nd – Sept. 5th = 4 pm – 7:45 pm;
Weekends/Holidays: 12:00 pm – 7:45 pm

Westchester: Opens May 28th to Sept. 5th (Labor Day)
Hours*: May 28th – August 21st = 12:00 pm – 7:45 pm
August 22nd – Sept. 5th = 4 pm – 7:45 pm;
Weekends/Holidays: 12:00 pm – 7:45 pm

* **BOTH pools will not be open daily. A schedule will be posted on Facebook and on our website of when each pool will be open.**

Please note that pool hours MAY shorten towards the middle of August as nights become shorter and colder and are subject to change.

The pools may close due to inclement weather at the discretion of the pool manager and/or FHPOA Board. If the pool closes due to inclement weather, residents are required to leave the pool area. The pool will re-open if weather permits. Pool hours are subject to interruption due to swimming programs, and/or FHPOA Events. **We will ADD pool hours, IF possible, with staffing.**

If the gate is locked and/or no guard is on duty, STAY OUT!

Use of Pool:

ANY Association Member/Family that is NOT current with their Association dues (including past dues) is not permitted to use the pool facilities OR be a guest of another Association member. Pool TAGS MUST be shown upon entering pool areas.

Guest Restrictions:

ALL guests must be accompanied by a member of the association. There are NO exceptions to this rule! Guests must be made aware of pool rules and association members will be accountable for their guest's actions. Members must register ALL of their guests in the sign-in book available at each pool. Please limit the number of guests you bring per visit (10- to 14-year-olds can bring 1 guest per visit, 15- to 17-year-olds can bring 2 guests per visit, and adults may bring a reasonable number of guests per visit). Lifeguards reserve the right to ask any guest(s) to leave if necessary or if we have too many people in the pool area.

Pool RULES:

- Current members must show pool tag to lifeguard(s) upon arrival to the pool and sign-in. **No one will be permitted to enter the pool area without a pool tag.** Any staff and/or board member may ask to see your pool tag at any time. There is a small fee for replacement of tags and there will be one tag per household.
- No running or horseplay will be tolerated in the pool or surrounding area. There is NO diving at Westchester Pool. Diving is permitted at Skyview Pool along the deep end (west side) only!
- All swimmers must wear a standard swimsuit. NO cut-offs, sweatshirts, pants, Capri's, etc...
- Non-toilet trained children MUST wear swim diapers.

- Acceptable toys in the pool: soft balls, noodles, face mask, goggles, snorkel, fins, dolls, water cans, dive toys or any plastic toy. Lifeguard has final decision and may restrict toys if they feel they may cause a safety hazard.
- Unacceptable toys in the pool: inner tubes, large rafts, tennis balls, football or any other type of hard ball.
- Flotation devices are permitted in shallow end ONLY. An adult MUST accompany the child in the water and be next to the child using the safety floatation device.
- NO abusive language will be tolerated. You will be asked to leave immediately.
- No one is permitted in the pump/furnace rooms.
- Swimmers will be given a deep-water test if there is any question of swimming ability. This is at the discretion of the lifeguard on duty. Parents may NOT override the guard's decision.
- Parents of young children must keep a watchful eye on their children. If they are playing on the steps at the Westchester pool, parents should be sitting with them. YOUR children are your responsibility!
- Children 10 years and younger must be accompanied by a parent/adult (18+) or responsible caregiver between the ages of 15 to 17 years old.
- NO glass containers of any kind are permitted in or around pool area.
- **NO alcoholic beverages are permitted in or around pool area.**
- NO smoking or vaping is permitted in or around pool area.
- NO bikes, scooters or skateboards are allowed in pool area.
- NO pets, balloons, or weapons of any kind are permitted in pool area.
- **PLEASE do NOT take pictures of guards. If you have an issue with a guard, please notify the FH Board.**

Safety Breaks: Safety breaks are every hour/last 15 min. of hour. ALL children must clear the pool. **Adults ONLY (18 years or older) may stay in the water during this time to swim at their own risk. NO children of any age, NO exceptions.**

Covid/Health Rules: Please do NOT swim if you have open sores, inflamed eye(s) or any other communicable disease, or diarrhea. If you have had diarrhea, please refrain from swimming for 2 weeks. This will help keep our pool free from Recreational Water Diseases. Remove all bandages before entering the pool.

Please DO NOT enter the pool area if you have tested positive for Covid, are in quarantine for Covid, been exposed to Covid and/or if someone in your household has tested positive for Covid. The guards will not police these guidelines but please respect others.

Food: Food and snacks are permitted in the pool area but please clean-up after yourself.

Pool Rental: NO POOL RENTALS THIS YEAR

Tennis Courts: When using the tennis courts please have your pool tag with you.
